

The True Witness desires to remedy the perilous condition in which his professed people are placed, and he says: . . . (Revelation 2:4-5) Christ will cease to take the names of those who fail to turn to him and do their first works, and will no longer make intercession for them before the Father. He says,(Revelation 3:15-18) Though the professed followers of Christ are in a deplorable condition, they are not yet in so desperate a strait as were the foolish virgins whose lamps were going out, and there was no time in which to replenish their vessels with oil. When the bridegroom came, those that were ready went in with him to the wedding; but when the foolish virgins came, the door was shut, and they were too late to obtain an entrance. But the counsel of the True Witness does not represent those who are lukewarm as in a hopeless case. There is yet a chance to remedy their state, and the Laodicean message is full of encouragement; for the backslidden church may yet buy the gold of faith and love, may yet have the white robe of the that the shame of their nakedness need not righteousness of Christ, appear. Today the question is to come home to every heart, Do you believe in the Son of God? Many accept of the theory of Christ, but they make it manifest by their works that they do not know him as the Saviour who died for the sins of men, who bore the penalty of their transgression, in order that they might be brought back to their loyalty to God, and through the merits of a crucified and risen Saviour, might find acceptance with God in their obedience to his law.
