all the reformers of course had
21:54
identified the beast with the Roman
21:57
Catholic system and the Roman Catholic

system has a social doctrine now it's
22:04
interesting that in this election Bernie

Sanders is the one that absolutely

embodies the social system

of the Vatican in fact he attended the

course at the Vatican and he agrees with

political system so Donald Trump stands

for this individualism and capitalism

the super rich and the super poor now
