was the day of judgment so on that day

04:22

they would fast that they would search

04:28

their souls to see what is inside of

04:32

them in other words they'll do

04:35

introspection to see whether they are

04:37

right with God it was a solemn day and

04:40

on that day they had to bring two goats

04:44

and they cost lots for the goats and

04:50

then when the lot was had determined one

04:53

of them became the Lord's goat and the

04:56

other one became the scapegoat now the

04:59

Lord's goat was sacrificed and the high

05:04

priest took that blood into the

05:08

sanctuary and he went into the most holy

05:11

it was a very solemn occasion and

05:14

remember they had little bells around

05:17

the bottom and everybody was listening

05:19

carefully because in the past it had

happened and if someone was careless and

05:26

they went into the most holy or weren't

05:30

entitled to be there they could be

05:32

struck dead so there was a lot of

05:36

introspection am i right with God and

05:38

the high priest would go in and he would

05:41

make atonement for the sanctuary now

05:45

obviously the century doesn't serve it's

05:48

a building right yes or it's a structure

05:51

so what kind of atonement atonement is

05:57

well let's put it this way Tyndale put

06:00

it nicely he actually coined the phrase

06:03

it meant at one mint and a gray tone out

06:07

now at one mint it's actually worth that

06:11

he made up to explain how God associated

06:17

himself with humanity and became one

06:19

with them and took the place of and paid

06:23

the price for as though he were the

06:27

guilty party although he wasn't yes and

06:29

so you when you when they made atonement

06:32

for the sanctuary the record of sin was

06:37

removed these are all the confessed sins

06:40

now remember Jesus had already paid the

price for those sins and the price was

06:46

death yes the wages of sin is death so

06:50

the price for those sins has been fully

06:54

paid you know in fact the price for all

06:58

sin for all of humanity was paid on the

07:04

cross yes but not everybody appropriates

07:07

it only those who confess their sins and

07:11

forsake their sins

07:13

oh those sins that are carried into the

07:17

sanctuary now so the redeemed sins the

07:21

record of sin is there now that record

07:25

of sin has to be removed and this is

07:28

what happened on the day of atonement

07:30

so in type he removed the record of sin

07:36

and it started in the most holy and he

07:39

sprinkled the blood on the Ark of the

07:42

Covenant remember the Ark of the

07:43

Covenant contained the ten commandments

07:46

which are the standard of God's

07:48

righteousness and his law is the Ten

07:52

Commandments condemned me to death

07:54

and so in type the condemnation is

77.59

removed the sin the recorded sin on the

horns of the ALF altar is removed as he

08:07

moves into the holy the whole structure

08:11

everything that dealt with how to deal

08:14

with the sin sin issue is basically

08:17

removed the record of confessed son yes

08:20

and then the high priest word in type

08:24

place his hands upon the scapegoat and

08:28

in type the record of confessed sins

08:32

that had already been accounted for by

08.34

the blood of Jesus Christ was placed on

08:37

the scapegoat but the scapegoat doesn't

08:40

die at that point he's led into the

08:43

wilderness this by a strong man and then

08:48

he is let loose now what does that

08:51

entail and who is the scapegoat

08:53

well the scapegoat was also known as

08:56

as I sell which is a symbol of the devil

08:59

so who actually initiated sin in the

09:03

universe was the deadness and who caused

09:06

man to serve it was the devil that

09:10

caused man Tosun now some people cling

09:13

to sin and some people are willing to

09:17

forsake sin and all those records of

four-second forgiven sins are placed

09:25

onto the scapegoat the real culprit who 09:28

actually produced those sins yes but he 09:31

doesn't become the son baron because it 09:33

doesn't pay the price for those sins he 09:35

doesn't die doesn't shed his blood for 09:37

those sins yes

09:38

that son stays on he stays on his head 09:43

now the beauty of this is that when the 0.9.47

record of sin is removed from heaven 09:50

then you stand before God as though you 09:54

had never the center so how complete is 09:57

forgiveness complete it's absolute there 09:59

is not even a record of sin it has been 10:01

removed yes and eventually when God's 10:07

retributive action takes place and

10:10

humanity in the final judgment comes

under the condemnation and everybody 10:19

that has decided to cling to their sin 10:24

well pay the price for that sin which is 10:28

death nice and fire came out of heaven 10:31

and consumed them they shall be ashes 10.34

under your feet they were consumed the

ways as the biome laughingly about

nothing left so everybody that has never

confessed their sins will pay the price

10:48

for those sins yes they could have had

10:51

Redemption because Christ had died for

10:54

those sins already but they didn't

appropriate them they didn't want that

it was every plant every herb that bears 13:14

fruits grains nuts seeds there was the 13:34

diet of man no vegetables yes none now 13:39

what was the diet of the animals Genesis 13:42

1 verse 30 says and to every beast of 13:44

the earth and to every fowl every is a 13:47

very big word yes that doesn't exclude 13:50

any no it doesn't exclude anything every 13:54

beast of the earth and every fowl of the 13:56

air and to everything that creepeth upon 13:59

the earth wherein there is life I have 14:01

given every green herb for meat and it 14:05

was so so all the green plants so you 14:09

have your grazes that graze you have 14.11

your browsers that eat leaves there was

the food yes and some had specialized

14:19

foods now we must understand that the

14:22

antediluvian world was a very very rich

14:25

world and the climate was absolutely

14:29

perfect

14:30

and the plants that existed far

14:36

exceeded in number those that we have

14:38

today

14:39

heaven if you take the great oil

14:41

deposits in the world the great coal

14:43

fields in the world these are all plant

14:46

materials from the antediluvian world

14:48

that were destroyed in the 30s yeah and

14:52

if you go into the paleontological

14:55

record we find myriads of animals and

15:01

plants that no longer exist so there

15:05

were was a plant for everything

15:09

now I once gave a lecture called

15:12

creation to restoration perhaps you

15:15

could put that link how could linking

15:17

yes then we can see how the animal

15:20

kingdom originally was all plant eating

and how I can still find evidence for

that today even in the big carnivores

like it Alliance etc so the Bible says

15:32

everything eggplants there was the diet

15:35

of man and it's obvious there was no

15:38

death death is a consequence of Senya so

15:42

the plant world was created as food now

15:47

the Bible also says that the life is in

15:51

the blood now plants don't have a

15:56

vascular system they have other tubular

16:00

systems xylem and phloem etc etc but

16:05

it's not a vascular system they also

16:07

don't have a nervous system but they are

16:09

living their living food living food and

16:14

in Genesis 3 verse 17 there is this

16:20

statement and after Adam II said because

16:22

there's hearkened unto the voice of thy

16:24

wife that's a very interesting verse I

16:28

don't think we should get into that we

16:30

get into trouble with me if we go down

16:32

that route and has eaten of the tree of

16:37

which I commanded thee saying thou shalt

16:40

not eat of it cursed is the ground for

16:44

thy sake so what was cursed the ground

yes in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all

16:52

the days of thy life thorns also and

16:55

thistles shall it bring forth to thee

you unclean it says they're quite 22:51

categorically in the new translations in 22:54

the NIV here by Jesus declared all foods 22:56

clean well if that were the case are you 23:00

going to eat poisonous animals that will 23:04

kill you with one lick I mean that's a

ridiculous statement and they will claim

23:10

well Peter had the vision yes but what

she's Peter's answer three times when he

23:17

was told

23:18

buta go kill and eat and do not say that 23:22

is unclean what God has declared clean 23:25

while he was sitting there wondering

what the vision meant because it's it's

23:30

not so

23:31

lord I have never eaten anything impure

23:34

or unclean so while he was thinking

there was this knock on the door and the

three men stood they remember yes and

23:44

when he came to connealy is's house he 23:47

said God has shown me exactly that I

should call no man impure or unclean

23:55

nothing to do with diet so those rules

have been absolutely obliterated by

humanity so what were the prohibitions

no fat no blood no blood nothing unclean

in terms of diet but what was the

original diet yes totally plump rises so

his flesh and when we did eat bread to 34.05

the fall for you have brought us forth 34:08

into this wilderness to kill this whole 34:10

assembly with hunger then said the Lord

unto Moses behold I will rain bread from
