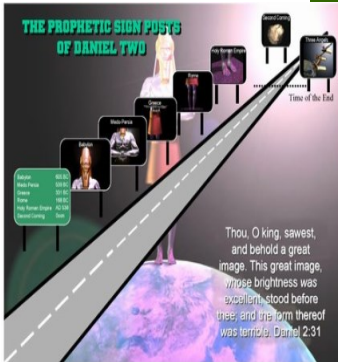
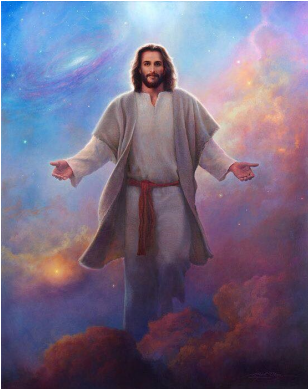


# The Lord's Forewarnings
